Fibre Broadband comes to Arnesby

BT says that fibre broadband is now available in Arnesby. You can check your speed at www.bt.com/fibre or at:

Terry Pike from the Peatling Exchange Broadband Pressure Group says:

It is likely that broadband speeds of at least 20Mbps to 30Mbps will be available to the vast majority of residents (much faster than the average 2Mbps at present!). There is likely to be a small extra monthly cost for access to the higher speeds but certainly with BT Infinity contracts there are various offers to subscribers who upgrade to the service and the increase should be quite small. It will also be possible to subscribe to even higher broadband speeds e.g. 80Mbps, at a further additional cost.

There is no obligation to switch to BT as your ISP (Internet Service Provider), as similar services should be available from your existing ISP. It is worth noting that there is also no obligation to upgrade to a contract for the faster speeds at all, if you do not wish to. With fibre connections over most of the distance from the exchange to homes, the speed of your connection should be faster anyway but we do not know yet how fast the connection will be without upgrading your contract.
