Access:

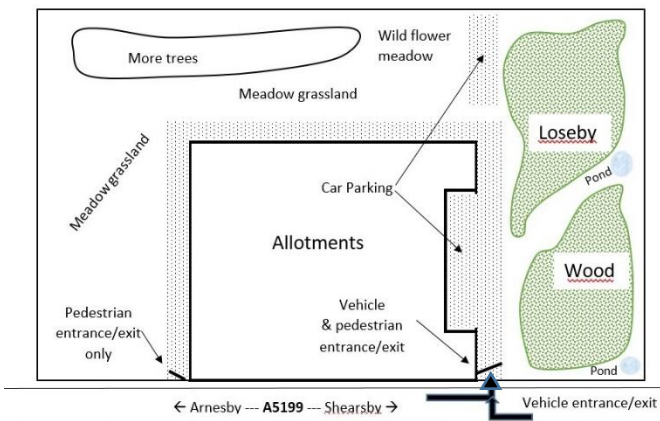
**On foot** – there is a tarmac footpath from Arnesby along the A5199 towards Shearsby all the way to the 1st gate into the allotment field. Then you can walk through or around the top of the allotments to the woodland area.

**By car** – use the 2nd gate (the Shearsby end), which will be left open. Please drive carefully keeping to the track and park where shown below.

Please **DO NOT** park in the gateways opposite the entrances.
