After 1st April, paper goes directly in Blue Bin. (The insert can be placed next to Blue Bin with extra recycling waste.)

Black bins

- Fridays 26th Feb, 11th March, 25th March, 8th April

Green Wheelie Bins – free collections finish on 4th April

After 4th April, only households that have subscribed to the new green bin collection service will have their bins emptied. It will cost £40 per year for fortnightly collections of one bin between April and November 2016 and during March 2017. Subscribers get a sticker for their bin. For more details and how to pay see
