Information about Parish Council Meetings – from Terry Cane, Clerk to Parish Council

The purpose of Parish Council meetings is to make decisions which improve service and amenities for the community. The conduct of Parish Council meetings and its powers are governed by Government legislation. The Chairman (or vice Chairman in his absence) is responsible for managing the meeting. Members of the public may be invited to speak at the Chairman's discretion.

Legislation requires that three clear days' notice of a meeting is given. Notice of meetings and agenda are posted on the two Village notice boards and on the Parish Council website. Dates of scheduled Parish Council meetings are published several months in advance on the website. Extraordinary meetings are called to deal with urgent business.

Members of the public wishing to raise a matter should contact a Parish Councillor or the Clerk. Details are on the website. There is an opportunity at meetings for members of the public to ask questions or raise matters for future business.
