* Children & pets are welcome, but please keep them under control to avoid accidents.

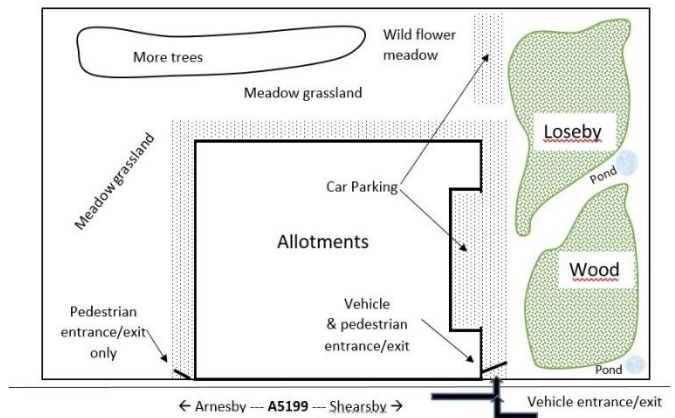
Access:
