Windows - Planning Permission & Building Regs

Bruce Kerr says: "Villagers will know that Arnesby is in a conservation area. As I am thinking of changing our windows, I consulted Harborough's planning department and they advised me that any changes to windows should be checked by them to ensure conservation area criteria are met.

The issue here is not so much the material used but if new windows match the existing in design. So, uPVC could be acceptable as a replacement for timber if the new windows are virtually indistinguishable from the existing. Apparently, the planners also consider they should be consulted over any change in colour, even if all you are doing is repainting existing timber windows.

And there may be building regulations which affect new window installations.

HDC's advice is that villagers should always email them at customer.services@harborough.gov.uk before replacing or painting windows."
