## History of the Arnesby Bus Shelter

*Extracts from the Arnesby Parish Meeting Minutes from Terry Cane, Clerk of Parish Council, Jan 2018*

*20 March 1951.* Decided to send a letter to District Council asking permission to erect a bus shelter.

*4 February 1952.* It was resolved that the first effort to raise money for the cost of the shelter be a house to house collection.

*25 March 1952.* Proposed Mr E. Neil be approached with regard to selling the piece of land adjoining the pen fold as this would be suitable for a bus shelter.

*3 November 1952.* Proposed accept the quotation sent by H.V. Batchelor Fleckney. This was carried unanimously. And proposed that a house to house collection be made on Friday 7 November.

Footnote. A plaque in the Bus Shelter states:

*Bus Shelter erected to Commemorate Coronation of Queen Elizabeth II, June 2nd 1953.*

*Voluntarily subscribed by the people and friends of Arnesby.*
