Access:

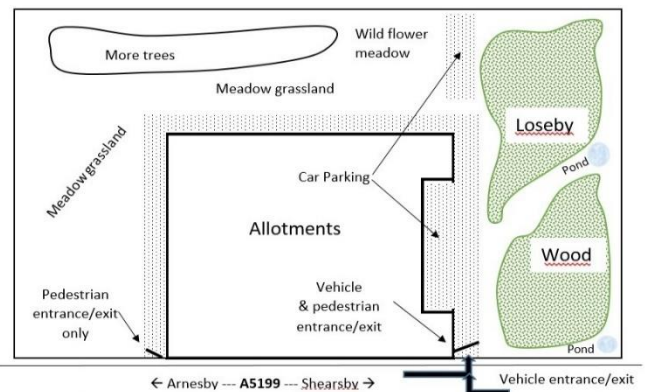
