Compost delivery – message from Sue Cooper

Simon at Premiere Plants is offering to deliver compost (delivery free) to the village on Tuesday 20th April at 6pm. The delivery will be made outside Long Acre, St Peter's Road for you to collect in your wheelbarrow/car. He has kept the price the same as last year. There are three types:



Growmoor multi purpose, which is a reduced peat mix without green waste in it - £6.50 for 75 Litres (it's on special offer)



Petersfield Professional peat based compost - £8.50 for 60 Litres



Petersfield multipurpose - a 20% reduced peat content mixture - £8.50 for 60 Litres

If you would like a delivery, please put cash or cheque made payable to **Premiere Plants**, in an envelope with your name, address, phone number, number of sacks and which type of compost, through the letterbox at **Long Acre, St Peters Road** by **Monday 19th April evening**.
