#### **Speed Detection Equipment - August**

From Welford Road, from 8000+ vehicle movements, 90% were recorded at/under 30mph, with only two exceeding 40mph.

From Bruntingthorpe, almost 6000 incoming movements, with 73% at/under 30mph, but 12 exceeding 40mph and some exceeding 60mph. Most slowed down to exit other end at around 32mph.
