#### Update on Arnesby May Fayre and The Queen's Platinum Jubilee

The Spring Bank Holiday date is changing in 2022 as there are to be nationwide celebrations of the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. The bank holiday will be Thurs  $2^{nd}$  June and the Jubilee Bank holiday Friday  $3^{rd}$  June. It is proposed that everyone joins in celebrations over the four-day weekend, including a 'Big Jubilee Lunch' on Sunday  $5^{th}$  June (details nearer the time).

To hold the traditional Fayre at the end of May would clash with the Jubilee celebrations. At the meeting on 15<sup>th</sup> November, it was decided to hold a fundraising event, similar to past May Fayres, on a date to be agreed later in 2022.
