#### Speed Detection Equipment – Lutterworth Road - September

Considerably more vehicle movements were recorded compared to August. Maximum speeds are generally lower coming into the village than going out. The Parish Council will monitor the data

over several months to see if further action is required.

At the Welford Road end: over 22,000 vehicle movements, 90% were recorded under 30mph incoming and 80% outgoing.

At the Bruntingthorpe end: over 10,000 movements, 78% under 30mph incoming and 50% outgoing.
