#### **Rosemary Wallace**

#### **Madge Eales**

Madge moved to the village when she married John Eales, an Arnesby lad, and they were involved with village life for nearly 50 years. Both were members of the Baptist Chapel where John was organist. Madge was a teacher at Arnesby School for 22 years. She taught many children of families who still live nearby, and many speak fondly of their time under her care.

Madge lived in Arnesby until 2015 when she moved to a care home in Lutterworth, after a fall downstairs. She celebrated her ninetieth birthday on 18<sup>th</sup> December 2020. Sadly, her health deteriorated quite quickly over recent months and she died peacefully on February 25<sup>th</sup>.

A service of thanksgiving will be held at 2pm on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> March at Arnesby Baptist Chapel followed by burial in the chapel graveyard and a wake in Arnesby Village Hall.
