The opposition know we have a mixed standard and will be fielding an appropriate team to play against us.

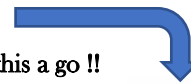

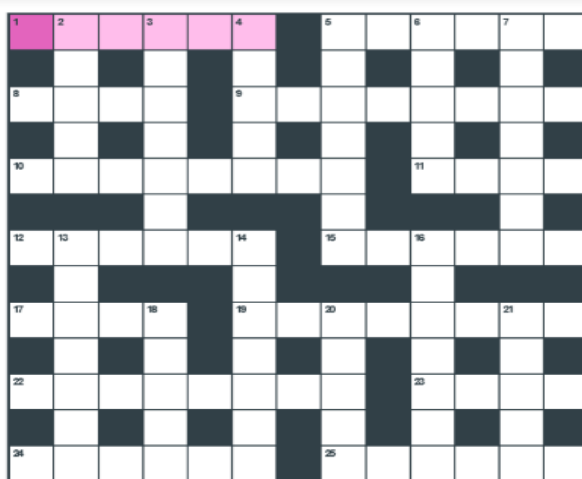
