Wildflower Verge – Opposite St Peters Church – Your Opinion Please -

We hoped to develop, long term, pockets of flora rich areas throughout the village. The aim still is that they become havens, rich in biodiversity for our local wildlife. These sites should become steppingstones for our pollinators and other wildlife along the emerging wildlife corridor throughout Leicestershire.

With the site opposite the church, we feel we need to do something different to make this work. One option would take the support and involvement of the village. **But we need to know if it's something you want to be involved in.**

- 1. Turn back to a grassed verge?
- 2. Plant a more formal bed with some shrubs and fill it with flowering pollinator plants to add colour structure. It would be rich pickings for our wildlife.

Option 2 would need work & volunteers help to prepare, plant, water weed and maintain this area. Once established it should start to look after itself but if we have another hot dry year like this year watering will be essential.
