I can't believe how we couldn't see how demonic, how much of a Satanic corruption of God's Sabbath, that was.

Sabbath was a gift of God to humans to bring us life. One day every 6 to climb out of the hamster-wheel of life, to just stop, to take stock, to nourish and refresh ourselves, to do those things that help us to flourish and thrive as human beings.

Certainly, God will always be a part of Sabbath. Human beings are comprised of body, mind and soul, we cannot therefore flourish as human beings without God restoring our souls.

Sabbath is a beautiful gift from God to help us avoid burnout and stress, to stop constant work from destroying our family-relationships and friendships, to give us time and space to flourish as human beings.

Sabbath is a God-given safety-valve that gives us a chance every 6 days to stop, to put down the burdens of life and to do those things that will refresh our souls, that will give us life.

In the Hexagon Benefice we meet every Sunday morning, precisely for that reason. To refresh our souls, to meet with God, to be renewed, to be inspired, to be encouraged in our life as disciples of Jesus, to receive God's power in Holy Communion.
