Preaching Cross

When I lived in France, I had a friend called Paul. He was an outdoors man - a hunter, shooter, and fisher. He worked in the French equivalent of B & Q in their ironmongery section, stacking shelves, advising people about the right screws, bolts and hinges they needed, just a regular working man.

Paul never darkened the door of a church. It wasn't really his thing. But he was very kind and helpful to me and I got to know him.

One day he took me into his back garden to show me his new chickens. As we went to the top of his garden, I noticed something a bit odd. It was a sort of little shrine, built out of rocks with a statue of the Virgin Mary in it. I said, "What's that Paul?" He said, "Oh, one day I was in a nearby town, and they were doing some renovations in a church and there was a skip outside. As I walked past the skip, I saw there was a broken statue of the Virgin Mary in it, and I just felt that's wrong. So, I rescued the pieces and got my neighbour to repair it. Then I built this little place for it. Each morning, when I come to feed my geese, chickens, and pigeons, I just stop, and I have a moment here."

It occurred to me that what Paul had done effectively, was to build a preaching cross in his garden.

In Saxon England around 800 A.D. most people lived in isolated, small settlements of about 4 round wooden houses. As monasteries, or minsters, were established, the monks, nuns or priests would visit the nearby settlements and tell people about Jesus.

When communities decided to become Christian, they were too few and too poor to build a church building, so they would erect a preaching cross. That wooden, or stone cross, served as the focal point for the life of faith. People would stop as they passed by the cross in the course of their working day and say a prayer. When the nuns, priests, or monks visited, they would preach and baptise in front of this cross.

For Paul, his little shrine served as a focal point for his life of faith. It made more sense to him than going to church.

I wonder if you have a preaching cross in your home or garden? A place you can make special as a space to spend time with God. A way for you to build faith into your everyday life? And, of course, we would also love to welcome you to church!
