If you'd like to continue receiving garden waste collections after 31 March 2025 you need to resubscribe on our website at https://www.harborough.gov.uk/garden-waste. To guarantee a continuous service from the beginning of April 2025, please ensure you subscribe by 21 March 2025.

We are also pleased to announce that the cost of the Garden Waste Collection Service for 2025/26 remains at £61 per green wheeled bin.

The garden waste subscription covers a 9-month operational service which runs from 1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026, with no collections in December 2025, January 2026 and February 2026.

Please note that we do not offer a Direct Debit or recurring payment option – you must re-subscribe to the service each year.

To help our crews identify your subscription, please ensure that you display your house name or number on your green bin.
